

All Souls Chapel

Today you can visit the All Souls Chapel to attend a Wednesday evening healing service, light a votive candle or pay respects to someone in the columbarium.

Did you know this room used to function as the parish hall/nursery (at the same time!). Prior to constructing the Ministry building in 2000, the main building had to handle all our functions. The current vesting area was the church office and the current nursery area was the priest's office. The vesting room was that tiny room up next to the altar (Sacristy). After Sunday service we would gather in the "parish hall" for coffee and donuts. There was a partition across the room so the south end could be used as a nursery during service.

Have you ever attended the annual Shrove Tuesday Pancake Dinner hosted by the Brotherhood of Saint Andrew? The original pancake dinner took place in the chapel as a fundraiser to buy uniforms for the Saint Anne Gargoyles men's softball team. Do you see the kitchen hidden in the chapel? Just kidding 😊.
